Recycling Policy

Whereas it is important to conserve our use of natural resources by recycling materials as much as possible and there is a need to reduce the amount of solid waste since landfills give off carbon dioxide and methane and the burning of waste does produce energy, but is expensive.

It is the law in Virginia that we must recycle a certain percentage of our trash and it is the policy of Fairlington Villages, A Condominium Association to:

- Urge all residents to recycle as much as possible
- Develop procedures that support this process as much as is feasible
- Work with Arlington County and the City of Alexandria to create a condominium community that is a model of recycling effectiveness
- Continue to investigate the possibility of recycling additional items and develop the means of doing so
- Monitor the percentage of recycled material to insure meeting state targets
- Exercise fiscal responsibility by developing economic means of accomplishing this process.
