- Buildings & Grounds Recommends policy regarding landscaping to the Board. Performs period inspections of the entire grounds. Proposes to the Board suggested plantings for the fall and spring.
- Communications Publishes the North Fairlington News monthly, maintains the Web site, and periodically updates the Resident's manual. Recommends ways to improve communications.
- Community Activities Organizes community-wide special events, which may include the Annual Yard Sale, Holiday parties, the annual volunteer pool party and other social events.
- Parking, Security & Traffic Performs periodic reviews and makes recommendations to the Board on all actions relating to parking and security matters, including lighting, patrol service, and towing appeals.
- Pool Makes policy recommendations to the Board regarding the management and physical condition of the swimming pools. Reviews rules regarding the use of pools and makes recommendations to the Board.
- Tennis Advises the Board on all policies relating to tennis courts and activities. Reviews rules regarding the use of courts and performs regular inspections of courts with Management.
- Variance & Structures Reviews all requests for variances and makes recommendations to the Board.
- Ad Hoc Committees Periodically, the President establishes an ad hoc committee to look into a specific issue, such as trash, pets, enforcement, risk management, reserves, etc. These Committees are specific and of short duration.
